Arrive in Las Vegas. You will be met by our representative at McCarran International Airport and transferred to your hotel. Check in to the hotel after 4 PM (requests for early check in are at the hotel's discretion). Meet your tour manager at 6 pm in the hotel lobby to start the tour. Dinner will be at Indian restaurant (walking distance from the hotel).



Make a regal entrance back at the hotel in the Limo once your tour is done. Overnight in Las Vegas.

DAY 02

Today is a free day to explore the attractions in Vegas on own.

You can choose to purchase an optional Grand Canyon tour while booking your tour with us. Choice of tours range from 14-hour coach tours of the West and South Rims of the Canyon to 6-hour tours by plane, with additional helicopter and boat ride experiences in the Canyon. All tours include round trip transfers from the hotel. If you have booked your Grand Canyon tour with us, our Tour director will drop you off at the pickup location for your tour. Breakfast will be packed for guests taking the Grand Canyon coach tours. If you are not visiting the Grand Canyon, we will hand out \$20 cash per person towards breakfast.

In the evening, enjoy a sumptuous dinner at the nearby Indian restaurant located at a walking distance from the hotel. Overnight in Las Vegas.



DAY 03

Check out from the hotel and after breakfast, transfer to Los Angeles. Enjoy some retail therapy at Ontario Mills, one of the top shopping and tourist destinations in Southern California. Shop at famous brands including J.Crew Factory, Tommy Hilfiger Company Store, Nike Factory Store and much more. Lunch on own.


DAY 04

DAY 05



After breakfast, enjoy a scenic drive to Yosemite National Park (approximately 5 hours). Yosemite National Park is the “Crown Jewel” of the United States National Parks system and one of the nation's most popular parks. The jaw-dropping head-turner of America’s national parks, and a Unesco World Heritage site, Yosemite is a visual feast of wild landscapes, beautiful vistas, and spectacular natural beauty. Its granite cliffs, great waterfalls, clear streams, Sequoia groves, pristine lakes and meadows inspire a sense of awe and reverence, and garner the devotion of all who enter - four million visitors wend their way to the country’s third-oldest national park annually. Marvel at the breathtaking beauty around you and learn about the history, wildlife and geology of Yosemite Valley’s most famous sights. Sit back, relax and discover Yosemite National Park’s incredible scenery and hidden secrets.

After the tour, drive to San Mateo (approximately 4.5 hours) and check in to the hotel. Enjoy a sumptuous dinner at an Indian restaurant en route. Overnight in the San Francisco Bay Area.





DAY 06

After breakfast, checkout from the hotel and proceed to San Francisco for a full day tour of the city that is considered by many to be the most beautiful city in America.


Take the San Francisco Bay Cruise, an exciting cruise of the bay sailing past historical and breathtaking sights such as the Golden Gate bridge, Alcatraz island, Downtown, Marina etc. Go on an expert guided city tour visiting the famous landmarks of the city including Fisherman's Wharf, Nob hill, Financial district, Lombard Street, China Town and Golden Gate Bridge Park. Enjoy an exciting ride on the famous San Francisco cable car, the world's last manually operated Cable car system, for a ride like no other in the world (if operational).

Enjoy a spectacular view of San Francisco from Twin peaks, the two prominent hills with an elevation of about 925 feet (282 m) located near the geographic center of San Francisco and offering one of the best views of the city.

End the tour with a visit to The Flyer SF at Pier 39 for a fun and exciting interactive experience with the whole group. Later, enjoy a sumptuous dinner at an Indian restaurant before returning to your hotel. Overnight in San Francisco.

DAY 07

After breakfast, check out from the hotel (check out time is 11 am). The hotel offers complimentary shuttle to the airport. Please check with the bell desk regarding shuttle timings. If you have any early flight & no shuttle is operational, please take a cab on own. (Shuttle timings is from 5 AM to 9 PM). Breakfast is not available if you are taking an early flight.



Domestic/International flights are not included in the tour cost. Travelers are free to book their flights on own with any airline of their choice. Arrive in Las Vegas (LAS) before 4:30 pm.

Grand Canyon West Rim COACH Tour with Skywalk

Price: \$195 per person

Duration: 13-14 hours

Pick Up Time: 6 am from hotel

Your drive to Grand Canyon West will take you over the Hoover Dam Bypass Bridge and into the state of Arizona. Make sure you have your camera ready for pictures of the dam, Lake Mead, and the mighty Colorado River. There are three sections at Grand Canyon West: Eagle Point, Guano Point, and the Hualapai Ranch. Eagle Point contains the most notable attraction, the Grand Canyon Skywalk, a glass bridge that suspends 4,000 feet above the Grand Canyon floor. There is a walking tour through authentic Native American dwellings, an amphitheater with live Native American performances from multiple tribes continuously throughout the day, and handmade Native American jewelry and crafts. The Hop-On-Hop-Off shuttle service will take you to the other points. At Guano Point, you can take the "Highpoint Hike," which offers breathtaking views of the Grand Canyon and Colorado River, or you can eat lunch on the edge of the canyon. The last stop is the Hualapai Ranch where you enter the Wild West and enjoy western hospitality, cowboy entertainment, wagon rides, and more.



Grand Canyon West Rim Coach Tour with Skywalk, Helicopter & Boat Tour

Price: \$391 per person

Duration: 13-14 hours including 15 minute Helicopter ride over Canyon as well as a 15 minute Pontoon ride over the Colorado river.

Pick Up Time: 6 am from hotel

Includes all attractions and activities covered in the **Grand Canyon West Rim COACH Tour with Skywalk**, plus a short helicopter ride and Canyon river boat ride. Soar like a golden eagle through the Grand Canyon past Guano Point, descending below the rim of the canyon to Quartermaster Point. This 15-20 minute flight provides sights and views of rock formations and the Colorado River only available with this exclusive tour. Also enjoy a 15 to 20 minute Pontoon ride on the Colorado River cutting through the Canyon walls



OPTIONAL TOURS



Air and Ground Tour of Grand Canyon West Rim with Skywalk

Price: \$350 per person. Add a 10-min helicopter ride over the Canyon and a 15-min boat ride on the Colorado river for an additional \$156 per person

Duration: 6 hours from hotel to hotel

Pick Up Time: Depends on flight time available

Fly like an executive on a deluxe flight from Las Vegas to the Grand Canyon West Rim aboard an elite airplane. At the Grand Canyon you can walk out on the glass-bottom Skywalk and you will visit Eagle Point and Guano Point.



Air and Ground Tour of Grand Canyon South Rim

Price: \$520 per person. Add a 25-min helicopter ride over the Canyon for an additional \$180 per person

Duration: 10 hours from Hotel to Hotel

Pick Up Time: Early morning tour. Depends on availability

Fly like an executive on a deluxe flight from Las Vegas to the Grand Canyon South Rim aboard an elite airplane. You will be picked up from the Vegas hotel & taken to Boulder city terminal where you will be checked in for your flight to South Rim. Your flight time is approximately 75 minutes flying over Hoover Dam, Lake Mead & Colorado River. After you land at the South terminal of the Canyon, a shuttle will take you to the Grand Canyon National Park. Enjoy a pristine view of the Canyon, enjoying nature at its best. Explore the many hidden view points on your own. Packed lunch is included in the cost.

- Children under the age of 2 are considered lap children. Proof of age will be required at the time of check-in. Please bring a copy of a birth certificate or passport.
- As per FAA regulations, all passengers 18 years and older will be required to show photo ID such as a driver's license or passport at the time of check-in.
- There is an additional fuel surcharge of \$15 per person to be paid at the time of check-in.

BOOKING & CANCELLATION

Booking: A deposit of \$250 per person is required to confirm your booking. The remaining balance must be paid at least 15 days prior to your tour departure date.

Cancellation: Reservations can be changed or cancelled at no charge, up to 15 days before the scheduled tour date. No refunds will be provided for cancellations made within 15 days of tour departure.

COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES

Guests are required to wear face coverings or masks while on the Tour and in Public spaces, and strictly observe social distancing at all times.

Tour Manager will check guests' body temperature at least once a day.

Hotels, Restaurants, and Attractions have their own COVID-19 guidelines, and guests are expected to adhere to their rules and guidelines.

Guests will be provided with hand sanitizer (one bottle for the entire tour) and disposable masks (one per day).

Guests exhibiting symptoms indicative of COVID-19 will not be allowed to continue on the tour and are required to immediately contact their health insurance company for assistance.

TOUR CANCELLATION

In the unlikely event that the tour is cancelled due to low enrollment or other reasons beyond our control, you will be given the option to either rebook on a future scheduled departure or receive a refund of all tour-related deposits and payments made previously by you for the tour.

We recommend booking flights with refundable fares and purchasing trip cancellation and interruption protection to help protect your travel arrangements against the unexpected.

VEHICLE

If a departure has less than 15 guests, the tour will be conducted in a large van by the driver who will also perform the role of a tour manager.

- There will be no vehicle available on Days 1 & 2 as the restaurant is at an easy walking distance to the hotel. Guests will be picked up at the hotel for transport to attractions on both days.
- Guests need to wear masks upon entering the vehicle for their pick up and drop-off from/to the airport.
- For the comfort of all guests, we request that you travel light (recommended luggage: one carry on and one international size suitcase)
- All the hotels/restaurants/attractions confirmed for this tour comply to COVID guidelines as mandated by CDC. Guests will have to follow the rules while in the premises of hotels and attractions.
- Check in time at hotels is 3 pm while the check out is 11 am. If guests want to extend their stay, they can contact the front desk.
- Portorage/Baggage Handling services are not included. If guests require this service, they can contact the bell desk at respective hotel and pay on own.
- Our Tour manager will meet the group in the hotel lobby at 6 pm.
- We have a couple of locations where restaurants are located within walking distance from the hotel. Guests who are not keen on walking can take an Uber or a cab to reach the destination on their own.
- Wheelchair passengers, if planning on joining our tour will need to have someone travel with them to assist with mobility. The tour manager will be unable to provide assistance. Please note that our vehicles are not equipped with ramps and grab bars for handicapped travelers.
- Seats in the vehicle will be occupied on a first come first serve. The vehicle size will vary based on the number of guests. This can be a 15 seater/25 seater/30 seater/55 seater coach. For van tours below 15 guests, we will have the driver acting as the tour leader.
- We are not responsible for lost valuables or travel documents. We request the guests to take care of their personal belongings while on the tour.
- Guests are liable to pay for any damages caused while on tour either at the hotel they are staying in, in the vehicle or at restaurants and attractions. Damages must be paid to the tour manager before the end of the tour.
- The hotel in Las Vegas will ask for a credit card at the time of check in towards incidentals. The hotel usually puts a hold on the credit card and this hold will be released if no expenses are incurred. It usually takes anywhere from 2-3 weeks for the charge to disappear on the Credit statement. Make sure to get a Zero statement balance from the hotel. If paying cash to the front desk, please make sure to collect the same before checking out.
- If guests are planning to deviate from the scheduled tour plan (to meet friends, etc), this must be mentioned clearly in the email and acknowledged by OpenWinds.
- The weather can vary considerable depending on the month of travel. Please make sure to bring along clothing appropriate for the season. Walking shoes are recommended. Also remember to carry an umbrella since it can rain any time of the year.
- The tour leader reserves the right to change the itinerary based on the weather and traffic conditions. In case of any breakdown, we will try our best to fix the problem. However, no monetary compensation will be provided.
- Standard room is with King bed. For 2 or more passengers (maximum occupancy is 4 per room), we will book a room with two double beds. For parents traveling with children, we will book a room with 2 beds. Rollaway beds are not allowed in a room with 2 beds.
- Our Pricing for the hotels includes room rate, taxes and Breakfast if applicable. The passengers are liable to pay for any additional incidentals that they may incur at the hotel.
